Instructional periods and final examinations will be held during this week. Class sessions for this final week will be determined by the "DAY & TIME" printed in the Master Schedule of Course Offerings. Late afternoon and evening classes which normally begin at 6:00 pm or later will hold exams during the 6:45-9:45 pm time slot according to the schedule above (note that 2 ½ hour Wednesday evening classes will meet on Wednesday, December 16). **All classes meet during this week for instruction and/or exams. Graduate students should check with their major department regarding exam schedules. All exceptions must be approved in advance by the Dean of the College.**

During the final week, classes will be held in the same rooms in which they have been meeting during the semester.

Since the Final Class Examination Schedule is determined by regular class meeting times, students, insofar as possible, should avoid enrolling in class sections, including late afternoon and evening classes, which meet at times which would cause them to have three or four examinations on the same day.
